 - ✓ 5 to 9 years of service experience
 - ✓ Holding managerial level position, may or may not have Line Mgt. Responsibilities
 - ✓ Mainly involved in mid-level Roles
- **Inspiring Woman leader**
 - ✓ 10+ year of service experience
 - ✓ Chief Executive Officer/ Head of the Department/ anyone of decision making level
 - ✓ Mainly involved in senior or policy making roles
